# The Concept

- Concept approved in May 2018 by GEF
- GEF Project Grant in the amount of US\$1.3 million
- Classified as a Medium-size Project
- IDB is the implementing agency
- CCD, Ministry of Economic Growth and Job Creation is the executing agency



# **Project Objectives**



To strengthen Jamaica's transparency framework through the design and implementation of a fully functional and harmonized domestic MRV system for the effective implementation of the country's NDC and other transparency-related activities.

# Component I: Enhanced Institution




- Assessment of...
  - institutional arrangements across ministries and related agencies
  - on-going initiatives at all levels
  - transparency related processes
  - the status of implementation of climate change related projects (financing)
- Establishment of a National Transparency
  Working Group for strategic guidance



# Component II: Domestic MRV







- Design of methodologies for emissions tracking, verification of climate change adaptation/mitigation data and climate financing
- Improvement of GHG Inventory (carbon accounting standards)
- Technology driven: Digitalization and Systematization (Blockchain - DLT)

# Component III: Knowledge Management



 Centralized National Climate Knowledge Platform

 Electronic guidelines, standards, management processes, QC

 Capacity building and train-thetrainers sessions (partnerships with Universities for carbon accounting)



# **Expected Project Outcomes**



 Enhanced institutional arrangements developed for long-term planning and timely reporting

 Fully functional domestic MRV system designed and established to monitor and evaluate adaptation, mitigation, climate financing and capacity building




# **Expected Project Outcomes**



- Improvement of National GHG Inventory that effectively tracks achievement towards national targets
  - Taking better stock of progress and spurring further and faster climate action
- Improved capacity, enhanced inter-agency coordination and knowledge management established
  - Build capacity at national level with targeted training and peer learning



# Project Tracker


