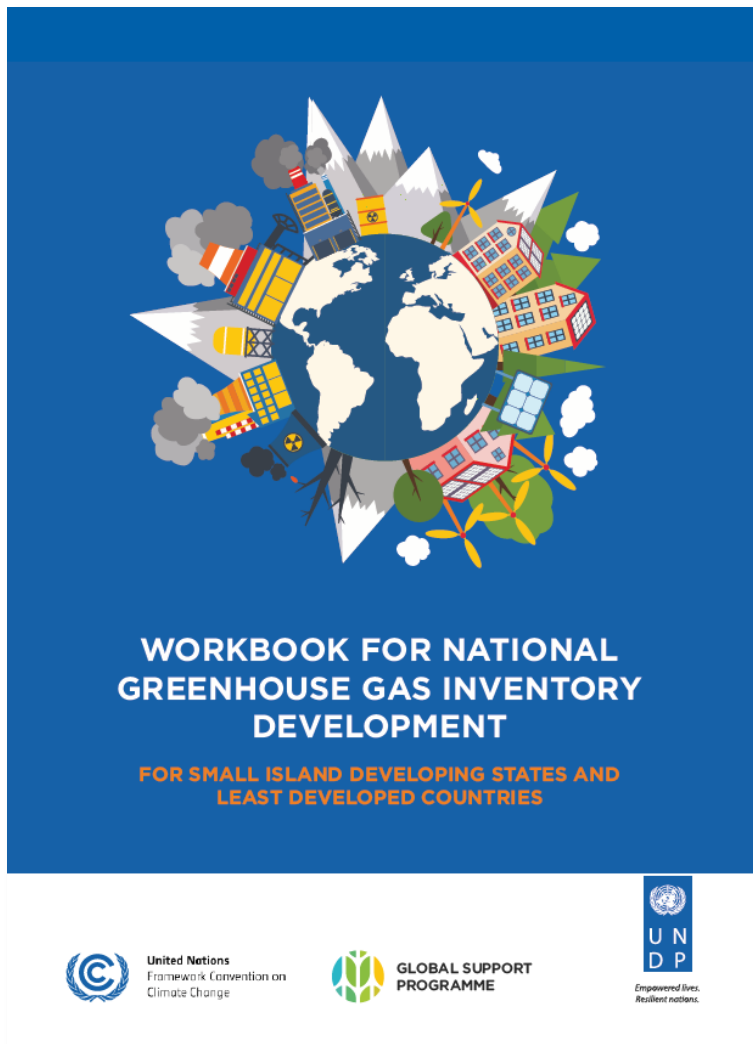


WORKBOOK FOR NATIONAL GREENHOUSE GAS INVENTORY: an introduction

Developing countries, especially those with the lower level of GHG emissions and lesser complex GHG inventories, such as smaller Small Island Developing States (SIDS) and Least Developed Countries (LDCs), continue to face challenges at each step of the inventory development process. These countries had expressed a need for guidance that is more practical and tailored to their needs and circumstances.



Objective of the workbook

The Workbook is aimed to be a simplified practical guide tailored to the needs and circumstances of the smaller SIDS and LDCs that provides **essential information, practical procedures and instructions in a concise format.**

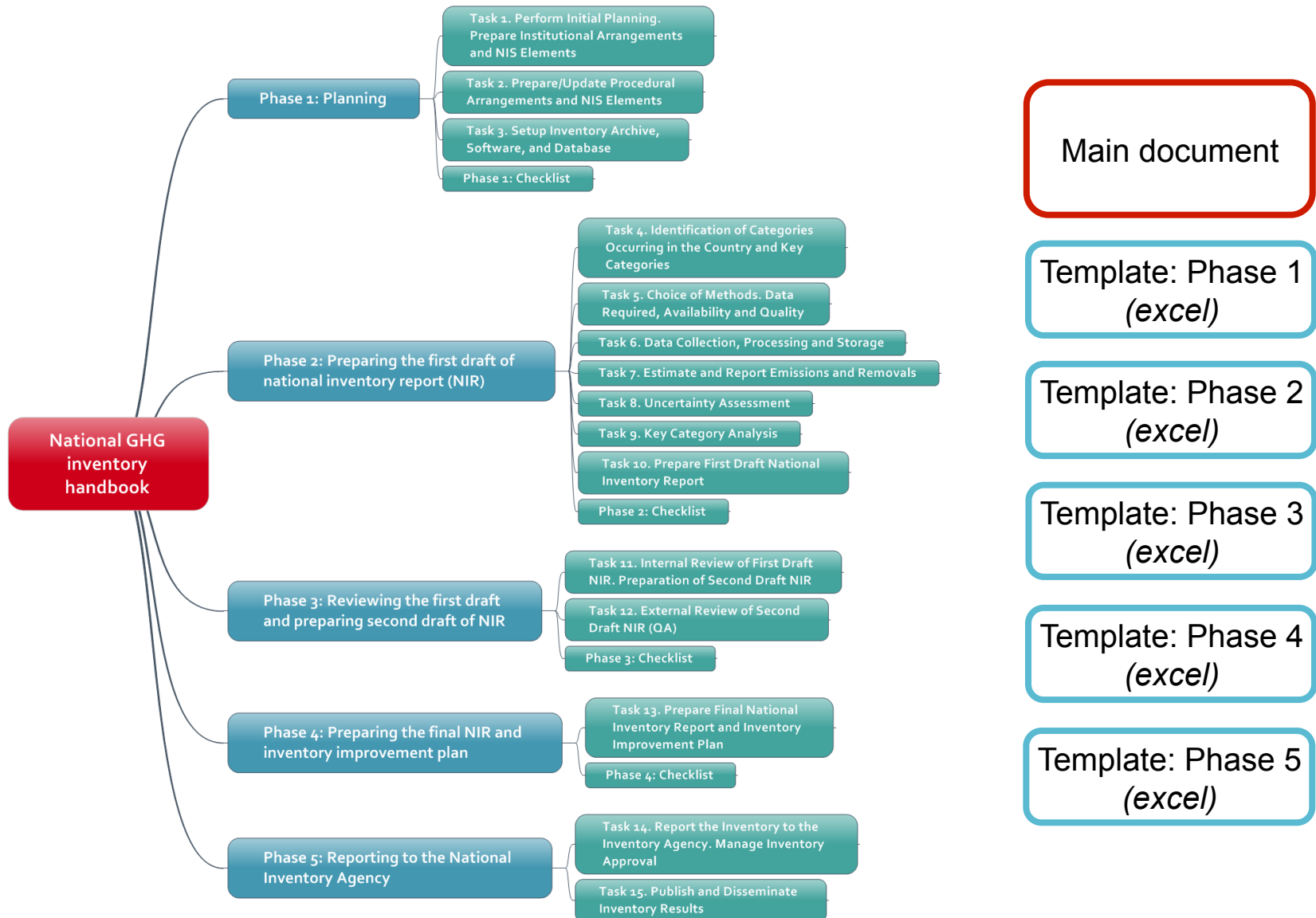


What exactly is this workbook?

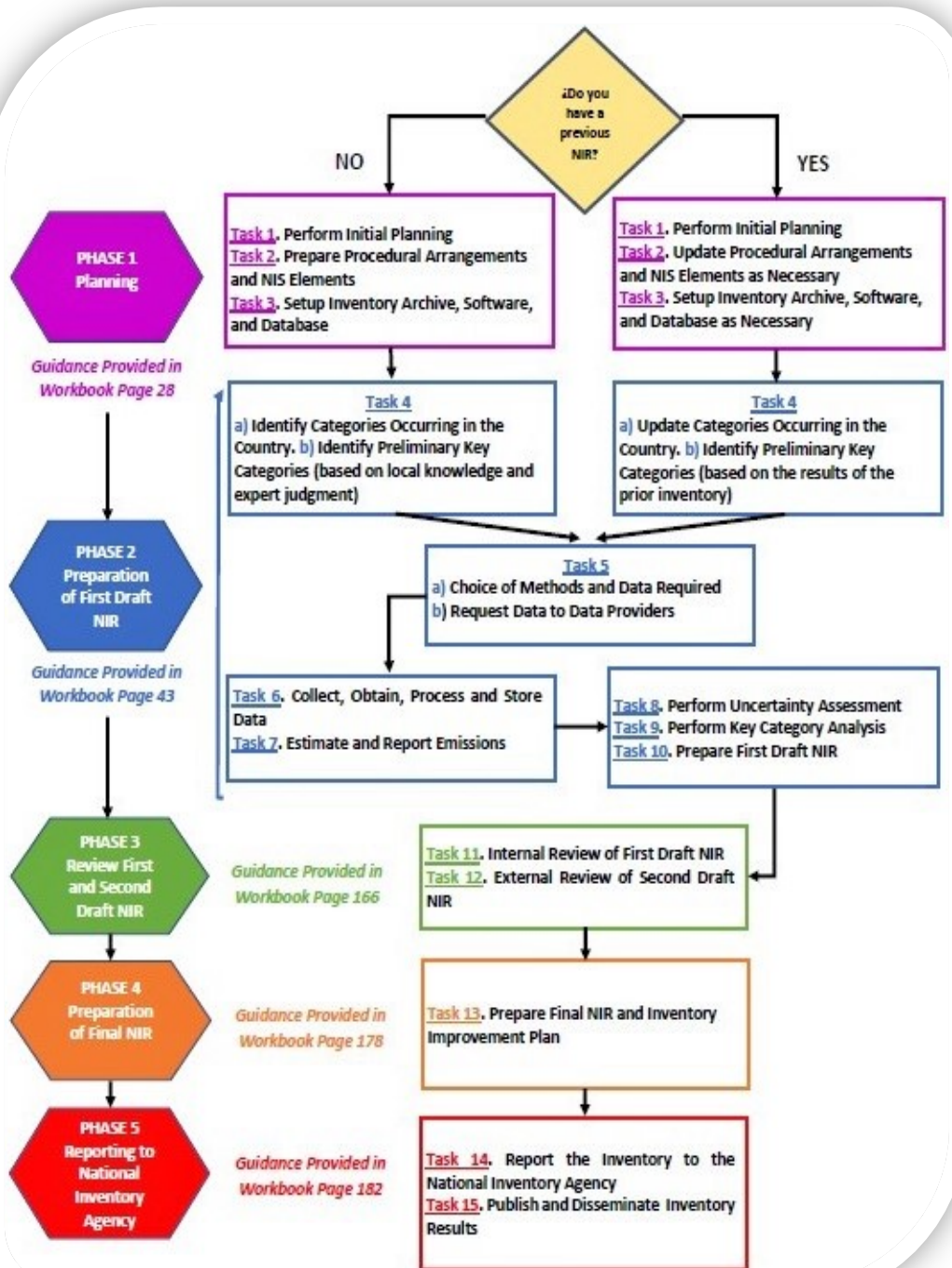
- I. Mainly based on the 2006 IPCC Guidelines and the IPCC Inventory Software v2.54, and complements with other key methodological documents and tools (UNDP, UNFCCC/CGE, US - EPA-USAID, EMEP/EEA, relevant decisions of the UNFCCC process.
- II. Does not intend to replace or duplicate the guidance advice provided by 2006 IPCC Guidelines and other methodological documents. Rather it aims to facilitate enhanced understanding and use of the existing guidance in a simplified form. *Users are always encouraged to refer to these original documents to obtain further detailed information and advice on a specific issue.*
- III. Does not take into account the extent of adherence to the provisions contained in those relevant decisions of the UNFCCC process, in particular, “the UNFCCC reporting guidelines for biennial update reporting guidelines from Parties not included in Annex I to the Convention”, or “Guidelines for the preparation of initial national communications from Parties not included in Annex I to the Convention”.
- IV. Attempts to address errors and deficiencies that have been frequently identified in the inventories of developing countries by suggestions and examples of good practices.
