
- In-depth country engagement in 40+ countries, including St Lucia, A&B, Grenada, Jamaica (emerging Belize).
- 15 Partnership Plans developed including St Lucia (now in stage 4)
- Building and consolidating institutional/legal/policy frameworks for NDCs (all Caribbean members)
- Mobilizing partners for collective impact and ensuring speed of delivery
- Engaging Ministries of Finance to dedicate funds and align budgets to turn plans into action (slowly emerging in Caribbean Members)

- Expand capacity to support members in mobilizing and guiding public and private finance
- Facilitate access to finance outside of development cooperation frameworks
