The **vision**:

"Having an operational MRV systems by 2020 in the ECOWAS countries engaged in the Initiative"

The objectives:

- Facilitating the exchange of knowledge in the energy and AFOLU sectors;
- Supporting capacity development activities;
- Creating awareness within national institutions responsible for data collection, inventory compiling and inventory archiving.





First annual meeting and creation of the Network (Lomé, 4-6 October 2016)

Main challenges identified:

- Need to set up the necessary institutional arrangements;
- Lack of technical capacities;
- Need to raise the awareness within the institutions responsible for the data collection/archiving.

Main solutions identified:

- Identification of 2 focal points for each country officially engaged in the Network;
- Peer to peer learning through sharing best practices;
- Sharing data (e.g. emission factors);
- Reinforcing technical capacities;
- Technical, logistical backstopping and/or financial support from UNDP/UNEP GSP, RCC Lomé, ECREEE, Agrhymet, UNFCCC Secretariat, BOAD and FAO.



So far, **14 countries** in the ECOWAS region joined the Network, namely:

RESULTS ACHIEVED DURING THE FIRST YEAR:

- Official engagement of 2 national focal points from each of the 12 member countries.
- > RCC Lomé covered the role of pro tempore **coordinator**.
- Organization of workshops to share knowledge on MRV and transparency:
 - i. Togo: First Regional workshop for MRV Network (Oct. 2016);
 - ii. <u>Sierra Leone</u>: P2P learning from Ghana and Senegal on MRV and SBL (Mar. 2017);
 - iii. Liberia: P2P learning from Ghana and Senegal on MRV and SBL (Aug. 2017).

Strengthening capacity building:

- i. Webinar about ICA (Feb. 2017);
- ii. Participation of 1 focal point, **Dr. Tiangoua Kone** from Cote d'Ivoire, to the CASTT (July 2017);
- iii. On line course series on 2006 IPCC Guideline Inventory.





RESULTS ACHIEVED DURING THE FIRST YEAR:

13 people involved from Network member countries (8 focal points) are enrolled to the on line course series on 2006 IPCC Guideline Inventory
