Project title : Strengthening the transparency system for enhanced climate action in Côte d'Ivoire

Project Objective : Strengthen the capacities of Côte d'Ivoire in the area of transparency, according to the decisions of Paris Agreement on Climate Change and thereby to achieve its goals related to low carbon emission development

Component 1:
Strengthening of national institutions for transparency related activities

Institutional arrangements for climate transparency are in place and effective

Component 2: Provision of tools, training and assistance for meeting the transparency provisions established in the Paris Agreement

2.1. Enhancement of greenhouse gas inventories, including improved methodological guidance
2.2. Design of a domestic MRV system

- ❖ Identify gaps and needs in institutional arrangement and technical capacity for implementing climate action relating to transparency
