Project title: Strengthening the transparency system for enhanced climate action in Côte d'Ivoire

Project Objective: Strengthen the capacities of Côte d'Ivoire in the area of transparency, according to the decisions of Paris Agreement on Climate Change and thereby to achieve its goals related to low carbon emission development

Component 1:

Strenghtening of national institutions for transparency related activities

Component 2: Provision of tools, training and assistance for meeting the transparency provisions established in the Paris Agreement
