
### Some suggestions:

- Coordinating public entity in charge of CC to oversee NCs/BURs.
- Steering project committee that comprises different ministries, meeting every 3 months.
- Full time coordinator.
- Training of local staff.
- Think of the domestic value you can give to the BUR.
- Elaboration of infographics/short notes to the public.
- Exchange of experiences with similar Countries.
- Use tabular forms and simple language whenever possible.
- Get national experts into the UNFCCC roster of experts.
- Engage local universities in the process.



# Global Support Programme (GSP)

- Provision of technical and capacity building support to all Non Annex-I Parties in the preparation of their NCs, BURs and (I)NDCs
- Implemented jointly by UNDP and UNEP
- It will be operative until the end of 2020





## Areas of support

- Support to prepare quality NCs and BURs to be submitted in a timely manner
- Assist capacities building in:
  - GHG inventories
  - Mitigation assessment
  - V&A
  - Institutional arrangements
  - Technology needs
- Strengthen linkages between NDCs and MRV frameworks



#### **CBIT**

Paragraph 84 of the COP decision adopting the Paris Agreement decided to establish "a Capacity-building Initiative for Transparency in order to build institutional and technical capacity, both pre- and post-2020 that "will support developing country Parties, upon request, in meeting enhanced transparency requirements as defined in Article 13 of the Agreement in a timely manner."



#### CBIT, as per paragraph 85 of the COP decision, will aim:

- (a) To strengthen national institutions for transparency-related activities in line with national priorities;
- (b) To provide relevant tools, training and assistance for meeting the provisions stipulated in Article 13 of the Agreement; and
- (c) To assist in the improvement of transparency over time



#### 1. Activities to strengthen national institutions for transparencyrelated activities in line with national priorities:

- (a) Support to national institutions to lead, plan, coordinate, implement, monitor, and evaluate policies, strategies, and programs to enhance transparency, including identification and dissemination of best/good practices for institutional strengthening and national network of practitioners;
- (b) Support on how to integrate knowledge from transparency initiatives into national policy and decision-making; and
- (c) Assistance with deployment and enhancement of information and knowledge management structure to meet Article 13 needs.



# 2.Activities to provide relevant tools, training, and assistance for meeting the provisions stipulated in Article 13:

- (d) Access to tools, templates, and applications to facilitate the use of improved methodologies, guidelines, datasets, and database system tools and economic models needed for implementation of enhanced transparency-related activities;
- (e) Country-specific training and peer exchange programs on transparency activities, such as establishing domestic MRV systems, tracking nationally determined contributions (NDCs), enhancement of greenhouse gas (GHG) inventories and economic and emissions projections, including methodological approaches, data collection, and data management, and adaptation monitoring, evaluation, and communication measures;
- (f) Development of country-specific emissions factors and activity data;
- (g) Assistance in quantifying and reporting impact of policy measures;
- (h) Clarifying key NDC information, e.g. baseline projections including for business-as-usual targets, and reporting progress towards achieving their NDCs; and
- (i) Assistance in quantifying and reporting on support provided and received.



#### 3. Activities to assist with improvement of transparency over time:

- (j) Capacity needs assessment for transparency, in particular to assess institutional arrangements for data collection, analysis, and reporting: (The assessment is to include a stocktake of the inventory and MRV-related capacity support provided by bilateral, multilateral and other initiatives, and incorporates the recommendations and lesson learned from that support. The assessment is also expected include an analysis of gaps in implementing transparency-related activities and knowledge.
- (k) Support to introduce and maintain progress tracking tools for transparency-related actions and progress towards targets/goals.


